GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of May 1, 2019 and are subject to periodic change.

The goods and services shown herein are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services. If legal or other requirements mean that you must buy any items that you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PAYMENT TERMS

To lose someone you love is a devastating human experience. It is frequently traumatic and can seriously impact judgment. We believe in the importance of the recognition and meaningful celebration of a life that has been lived and we will assist you in arranging an appropriate service to meet your individual and family needs.

It is also important to be realistic in respect to funeral expenditures. We do not want a family to spend more than they should nor less than they would like. What is important is that the arrangements be in keeping with a family's wishes and budget.

Since it is customary to pay for professional services at the time those services are rendered, full payment is due no later than the day prior to the funeral unless other arrangements have been made in advance. If full payment cannot be made prior to the day of the funeral, a deposit equal to one-half of the Funeral Home charges *plus* the total of all the cash disbursements is required. The balance of the funeral may then be paid within thirty days of the date of burial. For your convenience, we accept the following methods of payment:

- cash, personal check or certified/bank check;
- Mastercard or Visa up to \$5,000;
- Assignment of a verifiable and uncontestable life insurance policy;
- Pre-approved Medicaid payment, or;
- **>>** A pre-funded advance planning account.

Unpaid balances carried beyond thirty (30) days of the date of burial will accrue a monthly finance charge of one and one half percent of the unpaid balance.

BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our basic services fee includes, but is not limited to:

- 1. Responding to the initial request for service;
- 2. Conducting the arrangement conference;
- 3. Preparation of biographical and statistical data;
- 4. Examination of financial settlement options;
- 5. Preparation and filing of necessary papers, permits and authorizations;
- 6. Coordination with the other service providers;
- 7. Preparation and placement of the obituary notice(s);
- 8. Retention and care of the remains prior to the commencement of post death activities;
- 9. A portion of our basic overhead expenses relative to our facility operations and costs.

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee or a portion thereof, is already included in our charges for direct cremations and optional cremation choices, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING (including use of the preparation room and sanitary care)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing¹. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. If you choose to have an embalming performed, the decedent may be embalmed at a location other than this registered mortuary.

Please note that as per N.J.A.C. 8:9-1.1, no human remains may remain unburied or uncremated for more than 48 hours unless said remains are embalmed or refrigerated.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This package charge includes the local (within 10 miles) unassisted removal of remains to the funeral home, basic services of the funeral director and staff, basic sheltering of the remains (up to 48 hours), sanitary care, obtaining necessary permits and transfer of the remains to the airport. This charge *does not* include embalming (or any alternative form of temporary preservation, as may be necessary), a casket, alternative or shipping container, the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private prior to forwarding the remains, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include transferring the remains to another destination, the charges of the common carrier, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

- RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This package charge includes receiving the remains from the other funeral home via transfer of remains from the airport to our funeral home, basic sheltering of the remains (up to 48 hours), basic services of the funeral director and staff, the obtaining of all necessary permits and authorizations, and local (within 10 miles) transportation to the cemetery or crematory accompanied by a licensed funeral director. This charge *does not* include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery's charges for opening and closing of the grave, any required outer burial container or cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.



IMMEDIATE BURIAL

Our package charge for immediate burial includes the basic services of the funeral director and staff, local (within 10 miles) unassisted transfer of remains to this funeral home, sheltering of the remains for up to 48 hours, obtaining of all necessary permits and authorizations, preparation, sanitary care, dressing and casketing of the remains for identification and local transportation to the cemetery accompanied by a licensed funeral director. This charge *does not* include the use of the facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery's charges for opening and closing of the grave, any required outer burial container or cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

DIRECT CREMATION

Our package charge for a direct cremation includes the basic services of the funeral director and staff, local (within 10 miles) unassisted removal of remains to this funeral home, sheltering of the remains for up to 48 hours, obtaining all necessary permits and authorizations and local transportation to the crematory in a service vehicle accompanied by a licensed funeral director and, return of the ashes from the crematory. This charge *does not* include any sanitary care or preparation of the remains for identification, the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, either public or private, prior to cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the cremation process, which is a crematory charge, or any other cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The basic alternative container that we provide is a wood base cremation tray without an interior.
